MARCH RECAPS:

This March, the children explored Asia and the arrival of spring. They learned about Asian cultures, animals, and traditions through stories, crafts, and music. The children made paper lanterns and experienced Asian dance and songs. They also celebrated Dr. Seuss's birthday on March 2nd by reading his books, creating silly hats, and engaging in craft activities. On St. Patrick's Day 17th, they made shamrocks and leprechaun and learned about Irish legends and symbols of luck. Throughout the month, the children focused on practicing grace and courtesy by using polite words, sharing, and respecting one another through role-playing and stories. As spring weather arrived, they enjoyed outdoor activities, observed the changing season, and learned about spring weather patterns such as rain, sunshine, and blooming flowers. The children participated in activities that fostered cultural awareness, kindness, respect, and appreciation for nature's beauty, creating joyful memories together.
